KENT COUNTY TREASURER'S ASSOCIATION DEFERMENT OF SUMMER PROPERTY TAXES FOR ALL KENT COUNTY TAX COLLECTING UNITS OF GOVERNMENT

As provided by Act 97 P.A. 1992 certain qualifying taxpayers may defer the payment of their 2023 summer taxes until February 15, 2024. Taxes may be deferred on a homestead if household income did not exceed **\$40,000** in 2022 and the taxpayer qualifies as defined in the General Property Tax Act as one or more of the following:

- Citizen, 62 years or older
- Paraplegic, Quadriplegic
- Eligible Serviceperson, Eligible Veteran or
Eligible Widow or Widower
- Blind Person
- Totally and permanently disabled

Taxes may also be deferred for certain agricultural properties which meet the specific requirements of the Act.

Application for deferment and additional information are available at your local government's Treasurer's Office. Application must be filed with your local unit treasurer by September 15 OR the due date of the summer tax bill, whichever is later. Please check with your local Treasurer for that date.
